Class Descriptions:

Fashion Illustration/Branding: This morning class is the perfect way to start the day. Campers will learn from a professional Fashion Illustrator how to sketch the croquis, render fabric, and use paint, fashion markers and more to bring their design to paper. The perfect prep for someone looking to apply to fashion college!

Lunch: We have a refrigerator and microwave in our lunch room. We may also take lunch (as a group) outdoors weather permitting. Lunch is not included in the camp fee.

Sewing: In our sewing class students will learn to use the sewing machine to create garments of their choosing with fabric purchased earlier in the week. We encourage students to make three items in one week. Our studio also has serger machines, dress forms and steam irons as well as all sewing supplies.

Field Trips/Guests & Activities: Our campers will go on a wide range of field trips. Day one will be dedicated shopping for supplies at Mood Designer Fabrics (Included in camp fee). The rest of the week will include one fashion exhibit (Met Museum or FIT Museum), at least one exclusive trip to a fashion business or showroom and one-two guest speakers. Trip transportation is by private car service.

Campers work in a gorgeous 2500 sq ft loft style studio in the heart of Manhattan; featuring a sewing room, art room, 2 bathrooms and lunch area. Our camp instructors are graduates of fashion degree programs from some of the best design schools in the world, like Parsons The New School for Design & FIT. Our instructors and guests work in the industry as designers, stylists and fashion illustrators. Our teacher to camper ratio is 5:1 in sewing class & 4:1 for field trips. Campers will learn to sew on state-of-the-art computerized touch-screen sewing machines by Singer. The ability to sew garments, combined with our experience and amazing staff sets The Fashion Class' teen camp apart in NYC!





How to Register

Our fashion camp is for serious fashionistas who want to make their design dreams a reality!
 The TFC camp holds only 10 campers and space is very limited. We want our campers to get the most out of their experience and learn with other students who **love** fashion . We are now accepting applications for summer 2017:
